NOOSA ELECTORATE WINS IN LNP TRANSPORT POLICY

This morning Shadow Minister for Transport and Member for Maroochydore, Fiona Simpson announced the public transport policy for the Sunshine Coast which promises a significant boost to the entire Sunshine Coast including rapid bus services and extensions to the local route network.

Member for Noosa, Glen Elmes said he was delighted that his campaign to see the public transport link between Coolum and the Nambour Hospital has been realised, using flexible transport services and that there will be an improvement in bus services for Noosa with additional runs taking place via Moorindil Street and adjacent areas.

Glen Elmes said that Moorindil Street is a major thoroughfare in Tewantin, as it connects with the ferry service to the North Shore and services the Noosa Nursing Home, Sovereign Lodge, Riverlands Retirement Village as well as a large suburban community which feeds onto this street.

"Once the election is over I intend talking to Queensland Transport about further improvements to our public transport system.

"We must, as a community, create additional opportunities for people to connect with local public transport easily. It is only by providing additional opportunity that we can reduce reliance on cars, free up our streets and reduce carbon emissions." Glen Elmes said. ENDS
